Environment, Health and Safety (EHS) Policy

COMSATS University Islamabad (CUI), Wah Campus is committed to provide the quality environment to its students and employee to ensure their health and safety. CUI being a public sector University will implement all guidelines of the Higher Education Commission and Standard Operating Procedures (SoP) of Government Institutions to safeguard the environment, health, and safety of all university stakeholders. It is the responsibility of each employee and student to take care of his own health, safety, and surrounding environment. Each stakeholder of the university being a responsible citizen of Pakistan is required to bring in notice of the institutions, any shortcoming in arrangements made to safeguard the environment, health, and safety.

The effectiveness of environment, health and safety (EHS) policy is only possible when all the stakeholders of the university including employees, students and visitors adhere to the SoPs formulated to protect their environment, health and safety. The failure in adherence of EHS policy could lead to serious loss of precious life and damage to campus property. Moreover, the effectiveness of the EHS relates to the awareness of EHS policy among its stakeholder (i.e. students, employee) and monitoring of EHS policy implementation at campus level.

To be effective each department should devise its EHS Policy in accordance with institutional EHS Policy. An employee of each department shall be deputed as Department EHS Coordinator who will monitor and ensure the implementation of EHS Policy in the deputed department alongwith the recommendations to improve the EHS. All supervisory employees deputed in the university must be familiar with the EHS policy of both the University and Department. The EHS policy should also be printed and displaced at entrances and prominent places of the Campus for information of visitors.
